EVENT DESCRIPTION

The Deep Valley Book Festival (DVBF) connects writers with published authors and other experts in the field to share information, techniques, skills and resources. The Deep Valley Book Festival gets its name from the setting of the beloved Betsy-Tacy children's books written by Mankato-born author Maud Hart Lovelace. The festival is free and open to the public. Participants sell books or book-related materials, and hand out marketing and promotional items that support their books. The festival offers exhibitors the opportunity to reach book lovers ready to buy their products or learn about their services. Food and beverages are available all day. The DVBF provides a listing in the event program, website, Facebook and is promoted throughout Southern Minnesota.

VENDOR REQUIREMENTS:

- Vendors must be of a literary nature, and fit the literary theme of the event.
- Festival staff reserves the right to have exhibitors remove unacceptable or inappropriate items, or to relocate or dismiss any participant. This is a family event.
- Vendors are provided with table, 2 chairs, and tablecloth.
- Vendor tables will be marked with your name when you arrive at the festival.
- Vendors are responsible for their own materials (ie. merchandise, cash box, change, credit card reader, signage, handouts, etc.), and must operate only within their assigned space.
- WiFi is available.

BOOK SALES

- Bring and sell your books at your table. You sell and retain 100% of your sales.

APPLICATION DEADLINE & NOTIFICATION

- Full payment is due with your registration.
- You will receive a confirmation within two weeks of receipt of registration and payment.
- Placement of exhibitors is determined by festival organizers.

CANCELLATION/REFUND

- This is an INDOOR, RAIN or SHINE event.
- Entry fees are non-refundable after August 15, 2022.

SALES TAX

- The State of Minnesota requires any person selling used or new products to charge sales tax. Mankato, Minnesota sales tax rate is 7.875%

UNLOADING/PARKING

- Parking is free in the WOW! Zone parking lot.
- Exhibitors and Vendors must unload and then return to set up your table. After unloading, if possible park farthest from the building to allow plenty of parking for guests throughout the day.

ARRIVAL & SETUP

- Arrival and set up begins at 7:30 am on October 1. All tables must be set up by 9 am when we open to the public.
- Check in at the Welcome Table when you arrive at the WOW! Zone. We have a few dollies available for use if needed.

TAKE-DOWN

- Exhibitors and Vendors may dismantle at **3:00 pm. PLEASE DO NOT dismantle early.**
- Exhibitors and Vendors are invited to attend the 3:30 pm program by author Curtis Sittenfeld and load your car after the program if you wish. Take your cash box with you to the program.
- You are responsible for their own trash removal.
- Event staff is not available to assist with your set-up or take-down, however we will have several dollies available for use.

FESTIVAL REGULATIONS

- Festival staff reserves the right to have exhibitors remove unacceptable or inappropriate items, or to relocate or dismiss any participant.
- No pets (with the exception of service dogs), skateboards, roller blades, bicycles, or weapons are permitted at the festival.
- No food items or drinks may be sold by any vendor.

- All participating exhibitors are expected to promote on their website, social media and mailing lists to help us reach a wider audience. Sharing benefits everyone!
